






Key trends: Slovak students at SK UNIs

Research among the UA students in Slovakia

- Carried out from late FEB mid MAY 2018
- We tried to reach as many UA students studying in Slovakia as possible (1 822)
- Method: on-line survey, anonymous, 30 questions, in UA language, currently studying or just graduated (1 year after study)
- Received 313 questionnaires, we included 265 into analysis, 235 students currently studying, 30 graduates
